Communication Avenues – Update on ‘membership communication’ page on the website – Courtney S. Courtney said it is not quite as easy as thought. With some discussion and looking at past success/unsuccessful blogs on other AA websites he has hosted, the blogs, communication avenues on the websites were rarely used. Currently, with the SRG meeting monthly, there seems little need to have communication between meetings. At the end of publication of the minutes each month, Courtney S. & Carol P’s contact information is posted so if there is a need for someone to reach out, the contact information is available. On the SRG website, <https://secularrecoverygroup.org/>, there is a ‘contact us’ tab also available to all folks who may want to reach out.

Standardized format for SRG meetings, preamble/script changes – Dan W. After much discussion and review, please see the end of this document for what was decided on for finalization. One thing we decided is at the top of the hour of each meeting, to formally close the meeting and then continue with informal chat.

Group: After reviewing the attached, please come prepared to next month’s meeting to suggest any changes or concerns.

Add the Responsibility Pledge - Add it to the meeting script? If so, when? At the beginning? At the end? The Group decided not to add the Responsibility Pledge at this time.

Add speaker meeting – Until someone steps up with a desire to start another meeting, this topic will be shelved.

Revisit meeting rotations - which meetings will be on a rotating schedule – Courtney S. Spending a lot of time on the meeting script, we ran out of time and decided to add this topic to next month’s agenda.

However, Gail L. brought to the Groups attention, that Lioba was interested in being added to the Beginner’s Meeting rotation as one of the hosts, giving the meeting 3 hosts. There were no objections so Courtney S. will add her to the Zoom Host list.

Also discussed was the need to find someone to Host and co-host the Saturday meetings as Courtney is no longer available. Dan W. said he would do it if Bruce (Metronome) would be the co-host, which Bruce agreed to. For now, this will be a 3-month position or longer.

Review & establish guidelines for service positions. What are the requirements to hold a position? Courtney S. Courtney was unable to do the required research for this topic. We will add it to next month’s agenda.

New Business

Start planning the first SRG Webinar – Courtney S. / John C.

Again, as we ran out of time and John C. was not in attendance, this too will be added to next month’s agenda.

Group: In the meantime, think of subject matters and topics you would want to have discussed at a seminar. The hope is to have this webinar sometime in the first or second quarter of 2021.

New Business brought up during the meeting

Crosstalk – Robin H. wanted to know what, if any, procedures were in place regarding crosstalk during the meetings. After some thought and discussion, it was decided if there was inappropriate crosstalk, it is up to the Host to stop it.

Newcomers – There is much concern about how to reach out to the newcomers in the meetings. A few things discussed were:

If you want to reach out to a newcomer you should do so privately in the chat area. If you want to give your phone number or email address, that is a personal decision. Being a Zoom meeting, it is not deemed safe to have a phone list to distribute.

We are leaving it to each member to decide when and if to reach out, in the hopes that one of us will.

Also, it will be noted in the meeting script that a Beginners Meeting is available on Tuesdays.

With the decision to ‘formally’ close the meeting at the top of the hour and staying open for 30 minutes for informal chat, this also will give the newcomer an opportunity to ask questions.
